Vishwakarmay Namoh Namah...

It is a day of celebration for Vishwakarma, a Hindu god, the divine architect. He is considered as swayambhu and creator of the world. He constructed the holy city of Dwarka and the Maya Sabha of the Pandavas, and was the creator of many fabulous weapons of the gods. He is also called the divine carpenter, is mentioned in the Rig Veda, and is credited with Sthapatya Veda, the science of mechanics and architecture. The festival is observed primarily in factories and industrial areas, often on the shop floor.

As a mark of reverence the day of worship is marked not only by the engineering and architectural community but by artisans, craftsmen, mechanics, smiths, welders, industrial workers, factory workers and others. 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
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
